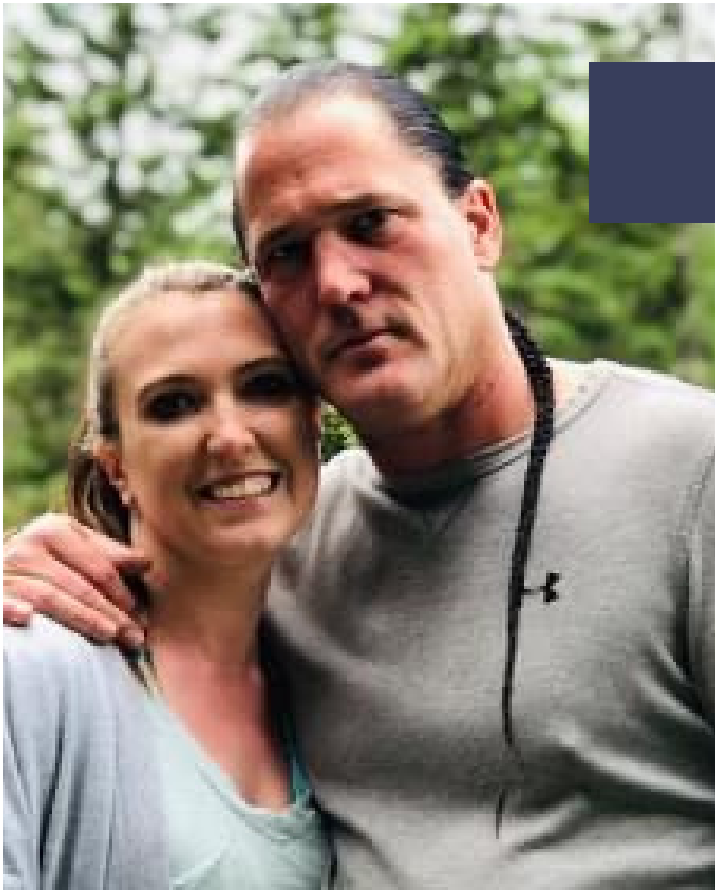
## HOUSE OF THE POTTER MINISTRIES

House of the Potter runs various outreach programs to help build relationship with youth and families in the area. It is their heart to share that our Father's love and forgiveness is available to everyone!

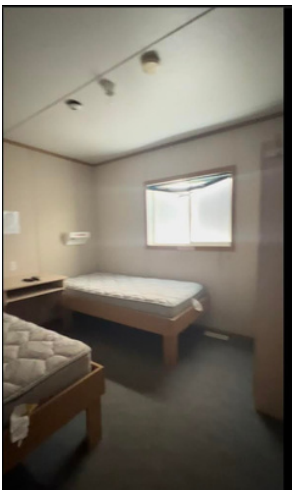

# CURRENT PROJECTS & NEEDS

## CAMP STRUCTURE - \$200,000

Our biggest project right now is the development of a camp structure for those caught in addictions, with a secondary use for elders and children evacuated from northern communities during the fire season. Sadly, there is not a spring and summer that go by that we don't see hundreds evacuated from the north to the Prince Albert area. Many are in need of adequate shelter. During the winter months we will be able to provide youth camps on holidays, and healing camps for the surrounding First Nations communities. Our camp structure will provide 22 rooms and come fully equipped with a commercial kitchen, bathrooms and showers, a relaxation area, and dining halls. The current goal is to raise \$200,000 that would provide two fully equipped and functional camp units delivered and set up!





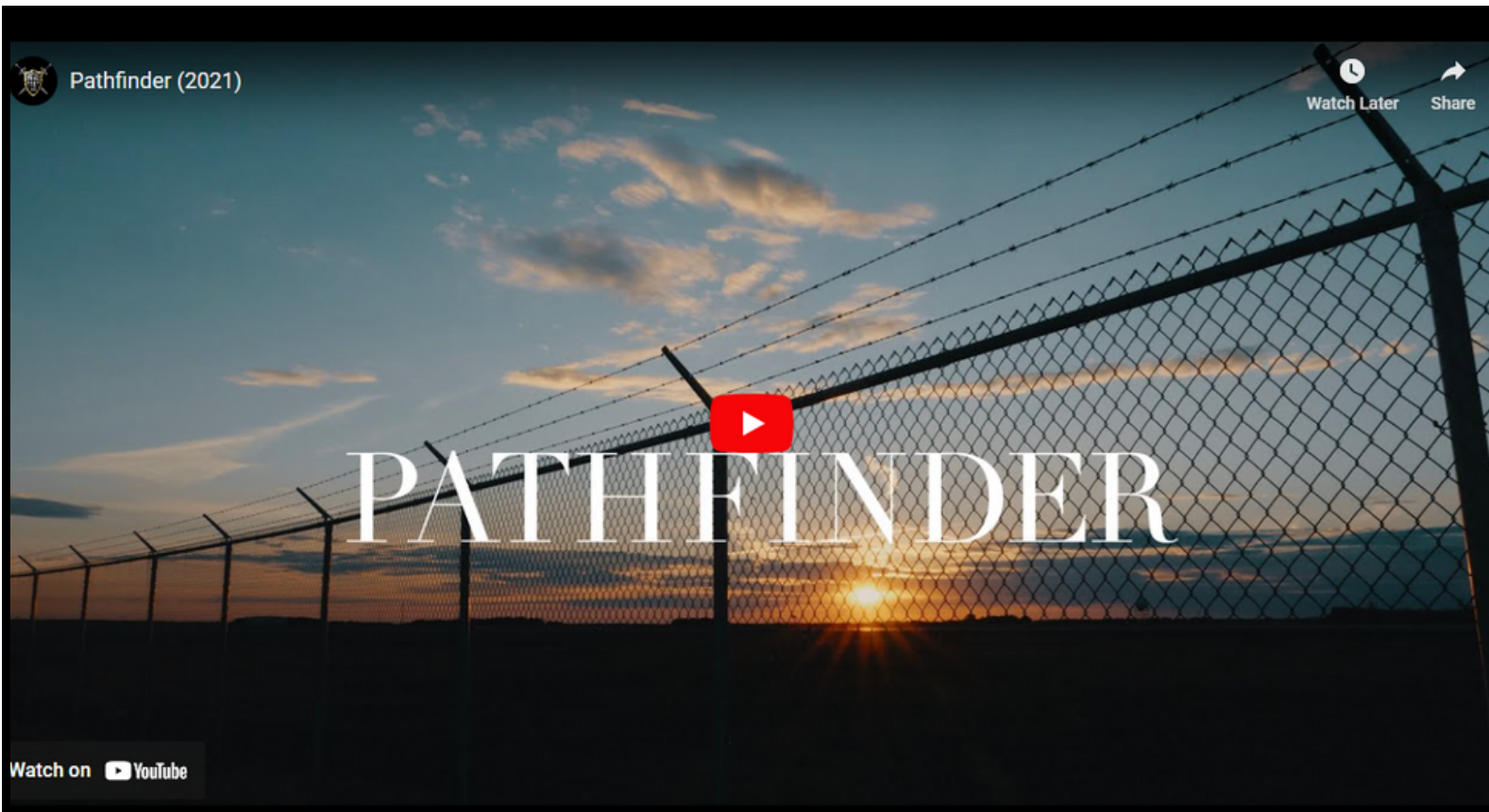
# CURRENT PROJECTS & NEEDS

## H.O.P. EARLY LEARNING CENTERS & H.O.P. LITTLE WARRIORS PROGRAM

- **Building a Missions Team** | Staffing, whether for our Little Warriors program or for the Early Learning Center, can be quite the challenge. We are in need of staff that are mission-minded with a heart for children.
- **15-Passenger Vans** | The vans we currently have are at the end of their lives and needing to be replaced. These vans are used daily to provide door to door transportation for the children in our Little Warriors program. We pick them up, take them to the H.O.P. Youth Center or out to do land-based learning, feed them, and take them back home. The transportation aspect is crucially important because we are working with low income families and without us providing the transportation the children would be unable to access our programs.
